General Board of Global Ministries networks with the jurisdictional UMVIM offices, which in turn coordinate with annual conference offices. It is a grassroots movement designed to provide an official channel whereby Christians, both lay and clergy, may offer their skills and talents for Christian service at home and around the world on short term assignments.
