HUMAN RELATIONS DAY CHILDREN'S ACTIVITY

THIS ACTIVITY CONNECTS THE PARABLE OF LAZARUS AND THE RICH MAN (LUKE 16:19-31) WITH MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. DAY AND HUMAN RELATIONS DAY.

In the story that Jesus told about the Rich Man and Lazarus, the rich man wants the chance to save his brothers from suffering by returning from the dead and telling them to change their lives and become better people. Abraham tells him that they already have Moses and other prophets who have told them everything they need to know to keep them in right relationship with God and with their neighbors.

Jesus taught us to take care of one another. When we see someone hurt, as Christians, we are called to help that person. When someone is being treated unfairly, we can look for ways to make the situation fair. When someone needs a friend, we can share a smile, say "hello" or sit and listen to the person.

This week, we celebrate the life of the Rev. Martin Luther King Jr. He was a minister and civil rights leader who worked to create fair laws for African-Americans. In his famous "I Have a Dream" speech, he shared what the world might look like if people cared for each other and treated one another fairly. Today, in our church, we observe Human Relations Day.

We dream about how we can help make sure that everyone has access to the things they need to live up to their potential.
