Supplies needed:

- Poster board
- Markers
- Stickers
- Glitter
- Other embellishments for signs

id you ever play the game "Follow the Leader"? Follow me and do what I do (make various movements including stopping and praying, singing a song, pantomime putting your arm around someone in comfort.)

Jesus came to earth to show us a better way to live. He taught us to love God and God's people. Today we heard about Jesus' new friends. He invited them to follow him. He told them that as disciples, people who follow Jesus, they would see amazing things through God's love.

People who joined King in following Jesus for civil rights carried signs and raised their voices in the streets and wrote letters to lawmakers asking for fair laws.

Today we will make signs that you can decorate and add your favorite quote or word from King.

Quotes and words the children might copy:
