United Methodist Student Day was the original Special Sunday. Dating back to 1872, this fund was the first collection taken in United Methodist Church Sunday school classes to advance the education of their children. The United Methodist church recognizes educating their children was and still is today a strong investment in the future of the church. The special Sunday was established as a Children's Fund and in 1940 was renamed as Student Day. Initially this Sunday was observed in June, but since 1968 it is celebrated on the last Sunday in November.
