
The United Methodist Church sets aside several Special Sundays each year to highlight ministries that embody our shared mission and witness as a denomination.

As faithful United Methodists, we have the opportunity to help our communities understand the purpose of each Special Sunday — and how their support makes a real and lasting impact through these shared ministries.


